## SHINING A LIGHT ON COMMON ORAL DISEASES (3 CE)

This course will emphasize the clinical and radiographic appearance of common oral lesions that clinicians will encounter in their practice. We will also discuss some malignant entities that can have a benign-like clinical or radiographic appearance and strategies to avoid those clinical and radiographic diagnostic pitfalls. This course will also provide guidelines for obtaining an adequate biopsy specimen and helpful tools that may aid in determining when a biopsy is necessary.

### Course Objectives:

- Be able to recognize common oral lesions.
- Learn how to develop a differential diagnosis for common oral lesions.
- Learn when it is appropriate to refer a patient.
- Learn strategies on how to manage common oral lesions.
- Learn strategies for obtaining a diagnostic biopsy.



**TANYA MARIE GIBSON, DDS**, is an assistant professor at UMKC School of Dentistry. She graduated from Meharry Medical College School of Dentistry in 2001 and completed her residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at Long Island Jewish Medical Center in 2004. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, a Diplomat of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and represents the AAOMP as a delegate to American Dental Education Association (ADEA) Council of Hospitals and Advanced Education Programs. She is also the Councilor of the ADEA Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology Section.

Her teaching responsibilities include providing the general, systemic and oral pathology curriculum to pre-doctoral students, advanced education dental residents and allied dental health students. Dr. Gibson is an ad hoc reviewer for Head and Neck Pathology and has published numerous manuscripts in peer-reviewed journals. She maintains an active practice in diagnostic, surgical and clinical oral pathology as well as traveling internationally to provide oral and maxillofacial pathology CE programs.
